




FEDERAL FUNDING HANDBOOK FOR MTS INFRASTRUCTURE

On April 4, 2013, the CMTS Coordinating Board approved the [Federal Funding Handbook for MTS Infrastructure](#), a single go-to source of recent (FY2012) and current funding programs for Marine Transportation System stakeholders. It includes over 50 Federal funding programs from at least 15 Departments and agencies.

This handbook is a tool for State and local stakeholders as well as any interested entity seeking programmatic information, including the MTS's stated purpose, criteria, list of eligible applicants, program point-of-contact, and hyperlink for further information.

Programs in the handbook include those authorized by MAP-21 (Moving Ahead for Progress in the 21st Century) and the Disaster Relief Program managed by the Department of Housing and Urban Development, among others. Types of funding include loan guarantees, direct loans, formula grants through which applicants work with State decision-makers, discretionary grants, and direct appropriations.
